Minutes of the Palo Alto Airport Association Board meeting, 6/7/2022.

The meeting was held by teleconference.

Andrew Pollack called the meeting to order at 19:33.

Gerald Barker reported that the association has 49 paid members and the account balance is \$5889.44. He noted that the budget for the airport day has traditionally been in excess of \$5000.

Mike Luetgens presented the airport manager's report:

- Repairs to taxiway Z are done but need re-striping.
- The wash rack is waiting for the contractor to schedule the work. There may be supply chain issues.
- Re-striping of the cable row area is scheduled for next week.
- Re-striping of the run-up area is complete. Harry Hirschman requested the airport to add a holding "spot" with a painted mark to the area between run-up T number 1 and Y1.
- There is a weed area near the flying clubs that will be covered with asphalt.
- The multiple bays along the airport access road will be combined into a single parking lot.
- A noise report will be sent to the city council. The final version will be publicly available. More complaints are caused by local rather than transient aircraft.
- There is no update on the mobile structures. John Carlsen noted that CAP needs the space since Palo Alto has the largest number of CAP cadets in the state.
- The tank lining project is moving forward slowly but there is no estimated time of completion.
- May traffic was up 18.6% over last year for a total of 16,566 operations.
- The tie-down wait list contains 70 aircraft, include 4 Pilatus, and many Cirrus aircraft.
- Tie-down fees rise by 4.2%. Andrew Pollack questioned whether the current rate is in line with fees charged at other airports in the area. Mike Luetgens commented that the City will conduct a fee/rental study.
- The airport has funding for one additional full-time position next year. That brings the total staffing to 3 full-time and 4 part-time employees.
- There is no news on the status of the night approach that is waiting for a survey.

Andrew Pollack noted that the Airport Day Steering Committee initial meeting was delayed form May 10th and will happen tomorrow.

The meeting adjourned 20:09.
