

## **Minutes of the Palo Alto Airport Association Board meeting, 12/6/2022.**

*The meeting was held by teleconference.*

Bob Lenox called the meeting to order at 19:32.

Andrew Pollack moved and Gerald Barker seconded to approve the minutes of the November board meeting. The motion was approved unanimously.

Gerald Barker reported an account balance of \$5808.68 and a count of 52 members.

Andrew Swanson reported:

- The tap of the water line for the wash rack has been completed. Next, the line needs to be flushed. He expects the wash rack to be available by the end of January.
- According to the latest standard, the night approach requires relocation of the PAPI. A siting study will be conducted to determine the location of the PAPI and a future AWOS.
- Availability of unleaded fuel has been delayed till mid-Spring due to supply chain problems in getting required equipment.
- The public planning meeting, originally scheduled for December, has been postponed till next year. City officials apparently consider availability of unleaded fuel a prerequisite for the planning meeting.

There was a discussion of noise abatement procedures and noise complaints. It was suggested to better publicize the procedures, e.g., through postings in the terminal and information provided to instructors.

Harry Hirschman suggested that airport supporters should regularly attend city council meetings and speak out for the airport.

There was no news on a potential Airport Day.
