## Minutes of the Palo Alto Airport Association Board meeting, 12/5/2023.

*The meeting was held in-person at the airport and by simultaneous teleconference.* 

Bob Lenox called the meeting to order at 19:33.

Bob Lenox moved and Gerald Barker seconded a motion to approve the minutes of the September Board meeting. The motion was approved unanimously.

Gerald Barker reported an account balance of \$6804 and a member count of 31. All but one of the airport day food vendors have made a payment.

Andrew Swanson presented the airport manager's report:

- 94UL is now in the tank farm. West Valley flying club is in the process of leasing a fuel truck for 94UL. Purchasing 94UL will require a \$10/month "fuel" membership at West Valley FC. Currently the price is \$7.79/gal. There was a brief discussion of the need for a WVFC membership due to IRS rules.
- Reconditioning the tank for 94UL cost \$500,000. It should be usable for 100UL when this becomes available. This is expected to take one year or more.
- The next public planning meeting will be in February. The exact date is still to be determined. There will be an update to the City council in January.
- The airport has acquired an electric van funded by an FAA grant.
- FAA wants to tie the ASOS and night approach projects. Planning is 60% complete and a grant application is expected in March.
- The replacement of the terminal building is supported by a 95% FAA grant. The project is expected to take more than 3 years. But the terminal building is not contingent on the planning process.
- There will be a short-notice meeting on noise abatement on Wednesday 12/6. PAAA will distribute a link to the meeting to members.
- There will be a Reno airshow next year on October 4 6.
- The focus of this year's California Aviation Day, Friday 27th, will be on schools and STEM education.
- There now is a pilot shop at the Palo Alto airport.

There was a brief discussion of web cams at Palo Alto. There was general agreement that a web cam would be useful but there are limitations due to City privacy policies.

Michael Mashack reported on a successful virtual ground school for East Palo Alto youths.

The next board meeting will again be in-person and via zoom.

The meeting adjourned at 20:35.
