- A draft of new noise abatement rules will be distributed soon.
- There will be a town hall meeting with the tower on April 30th. The tentative time will be 1pm.
- Card keys for airport access will be introduced on July 1st. There will be a 6 month roll out and starting January 1st, 2025, card keys will be mandatory. Pedestrian gates except the one at the terminal will also require card keys. There was some discussion on the impact on deliveries, renters and flight schools. The airport will work with these stakeholders to address their concerns.
- It will be at least 1 year until a new vendor for a payment system can be selected.

Bob Lenox proposed to print and distribute new "PAO" stickers to advertise the airport.

Ben Hochman discussed the state of planning for the airport day.

- The event will be on Sunday, September 29th, from 10am to 2pm.
- Volunteers are needed for the event, in particular for set-up and crowd control. There are no Palo Alto police cadets anymore. Boy scouts were suggested as alternative.
